Well-handled conflict can be instructive and helpful, but poorly handled conflict can be divisive and hurtful. I would like to have some helpers who can either go with me to help churches when needed. If this is something that you would like to learn, there are both online and in-person classes available. Let me know and I can hook you up with the details.

Also, I have not noticed anyone using the resource center at the presbytery office. Do we have resources that no longer are valued? Do we need to remind people that we are here? I am simply curious about the lack of interest – or perhaps it is just the time of year (we're all dragging after Christmas?) ....

So far, meetings with three commissions in, I am learning names and geography! The 225<sup>th</sup> General Assembly (2022) approved and recommended to the presbyteries for their affirmative or negative votes proposed changes in the language of the Book of Order that, if approved, will amend the Constitution.
