Dear Friends,

This stands as your reminder: **YOU are the presbytery.** The presbytery has few employees. The rest of the worker-bees of the presbytery are volunteers, who serve churches in many ways – some as pastors and others as clerks of session, ruling elders, deacons, Christian educators. Maybe that is why we are confusing. It's hard to understand so many moving hearts that are working together to achieve more.



The final core value that the Discernment and Design Administrative Commission has presented is **Outreach**. Many of your churches probably have a team that focuses on Outreach. We all try to live into our call to serve God's kingdom through reaching out into the community to serve those who need our help.

- Sometimes that help is very tangible: food, clothing, money.
- Sometimes that help is intangible: prayers, presence at vigils or demonstrations.
- Sometimes that help is made with a larger focus: letter writing or serving on city council, policy-making or policy-commenting, getting systems changed.
- Sometimes that help is a simple focus: talking about why we go to church, smiling at strangers, inviting someone to join you at your lunch table.

Commission for Congregational Life (CCL). Purpose: To promote and nurture healthy, faith-filled relationships within and among congregations and the presbytery through facilitation, communication, and coordination.

The Presbytery of Scioto Valley includes 87 churches with a membership of 12,996 (updated March 9, 2022). Surrounding the metropolitan center of Columbus, Ohio, the Presbytery extends northward to Marion, east to Newark, west to London and southward to the Ohio River. The southern portion of the presbytery is distinguished by an Appalachian culture, where there are



many small towns and much rugged open country. Scioto Valley Presbytery is represented in 21 Counties: Athens, Delaware, Fairfield, Fayette, Franklin, Gallia, Hocking, Jackson, Knox, Lawrence, Licking, Madison, Marion, Meigs, Morrow, Pickaway, Pike, Ross, Scioto, Union, and Vinton.
