Dear Friends,

By now you are tired of hearing about the Licking County Presbyterian Church Partnership, but I am going to share a recent activity. The idea behind sharing it is to start your imagination wandering...what might you and your neighbor churches do together in mission partnership?

This past Sunday 83 folks from five churches, plus some folks with no church affiliation, joined together to package 10,000 meals of dehydrated vegetables, soy, rice, and vitamins that will be sent into food deserts. It only took a little over an hour...and that included the time to get instructions on what to do! The churches invested less than \$4,000 to bring in *Rise Against Hunger*, a group that solely does this type of mission event to prepare packets that will feed six when rehydrated.

There were many elementary age children who ran back and forth between the tables where the packing was happening to the area where the packets were boxed. There were youth working side-by-side with older folks, all engaged and laughing and talking. There were jobs for those who wanted to sit, and those who wanted to stand. Music played. People sang and danced in place.

Every time the teams finished 1,000 meals; a child was selected to clang the gong (loudly of course) so cheers would go up from around the room.

I heard that the churches are considering working to package 20,000 meals next time since they had so many participants! Everyone left with a smile, a red hair net, and a feeling of satisfaction.

My goal is not necessarily to encourage you to investigate Rise Against Hunger, although that is a great hands-on mission project, but to encourage you to dream of what you and your friends can do where you are. Which churches would you invite to participate with you?

One of the goals of the Discernment and Design Administrative Commission is to begin building clusters of churches that work together, worship together, and learn together. That's a great goal! It builds on being a connectional church, it builds on being relational. Most of all, it serves to remind us that we are never alone because our God is with us always...through all those created in God's image and through the Holy Spirit. What joy!

Commission for Congregational Life (CCL). Purpose: To promote and nurture healthy, faith-filled relationships within and among congregations and the presbytery through facilitation, communication, and coordination.

The Presbytery of Scioto Valley includes 86 churches with a membership of 12,817 (updated March 20, 2023). Surrounding the metropolitan center of Columbus, Ohio, the Presbytery extends northward to Marion, east to Newark, west to London and southward to the Ohio River. The southern portion of the presbytery is distinguished by an Appalachian culture, where there are many small towns and much rugged open



country. Scioto Valley Presbytery is represented in 21 Counties: Athens, Delaware, Fairfield, Fayette, Franklin, Gallia, Hocking, Jackson, Knox, Lawrence, Licking, Madison, Marion, Meigs, Morrow, Pickaway, Pike, Ross, Scioto, Union, and Vinton.



Regarding Ruling Elders

Baptism is a life-defining event that emphasizes a commitment from God to God's family and from us to God's creation. It is not a checkbox occurrence, but a lifetime process that is complete only in death. Therefore, it is important for the leadership of the church to keep the commitment of baptism always present as it gets involved in Christ's mission by "studying Scripture and the issues of Christian faith and life."

Most baptismal services in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) include liturgies that echo the Book of Common Worship and ask the congregation two questions: "Do you, as members of the church of Jesus Christ, promise to guide and nurture this person by word and deed, with love and prayer? Will you encourage her/him/them to know and follow Christ and to be faithful members of his church?"
