Dear Friends,
Have you been trained in CPR/AED? (That's
Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation/Automated External
Defibrillation) If you have, you already know that even with
CPR 55% of cardiac arrest victims do not survive. When an
AED is added to the treatment, the percentage that do not
survive drops to 34%. So even with lifesaving attempts,
some cardiac events are not survivable. Did that just make
your day?



How many of you rode in a horse and buggy for your main mode of transportation? How many traveled in cars that needed hand-cranks to start? How many high beam buttons are on the floorboard? Things have changed in transportation. I saw that school buses are now coming in electric versions, reducing that diesel smell as the buses drive away or idle in neat rows awaiting students.

I mention this because it is similar to church life. If a church is stuck in "doing things the way we've always done them," people idle wasting precious energy. When we get stuck in idle, we forget WHY we do things because we are on autopilot. When we forget the WHY, we lose our passion, our connection to our Savior and Creator. Our hearts begin to build up with gunk, which threatens a heart attack.

People can change the condition of their physical hearts with better food choices and exercise. People can change the condition of the congregation with a re-energized connection to the "VINE" and excitement to serve the kingdom.

However, if the congregation has been "sedentary" with a "bad diet" for too long, even with lifesaving attempts, it may not survive. It could be that God is doing a new thing and that congregation will be replaced with the new thing God is doing.... It could be that many of our congregations need a wake-up call for that all important connection to the VINE. Holy discontent is that feeling that something needs to change to get back on track with God. Are you feeling content or discontent?
