Dear Friends,

God is so good...and the Holy Spirit works in amazing ways. A good many of the pastoral leaders and I just returned Tuesday from the professionals' retreat where we learned how to lead and preach in situations of trauma.



As we were preparing to leave Hocking Hills, we learned of the tragic accident along I-70 which took the lives of three students, two chaperones, and a teacher on their way to perform at the Ohio School Board Association meeting.

While the families immediately impacted were from out of our area, we all were touched by the horror. Seeing burned out wrecked vehicles, hearing from

children who were on the bus, and dealing with miles of traffic backups, we all were pulled into the feelings of the situation.

Everyone deals with trauma in different ways, but the one thing we all need to do is to keep our focus on God in the midst of difficulties. If we keep our hearts open, we can talk to others for support, and we can recognize that many of the stories in the Bible show us that in bad situations, God is still present.

We have all been through a big pandemic. We are all different than we were before March 2020. Our churches are all different also. That means that we all have some adjusting to do. We cannot force our churches to "go back to normal," because that normal no longer exists. We are all a part of that change.

I hope that you will recognize the changes, even mourn the loss of what was, but give yourself permission to accept what now is. We are all in this together...and so is God. Let's offer grace to our pastors, to those who are still in mourning, and then continue to welcome the new things that God is doing in our midst.

I will see you in First Presbyterian Church of Washington Court House on Sunday morning, then at Condit Presbyterian Church in Sunbury where we will install new pastor, Rev. Samuel Monte, at 3 p.m. Next week, I will be on vacation, but will be back for the presbytery meeting the following Tuesday.

Your Discernment & Design Administrative Commission thanks you for the many questions and comments we have received since we presented our report at the September Presbytery meeting. Your input throughout this process has provided the basis for the work we have

done. We are looking forward to the November 28 meeting when Presbytery will vote on the proposed Structural Design for Mission and Ministry. At that time, our work as a Commission will end, but our commitment to the future of our Presbytery will continue as, with you, we seek to be faithful to where God is leading.

Commission for Congregational Life (CCL). Purpose: To promote and nurture healthy, faith-filled relationships within and among congregations and the presbytery through facilitation, communication, and coordination.

The Presbytery of Scioto Valley includes 86 churches with a membership of 12,817 (updated March 20, 2023). Surrounding the metropolitan center of Columbus, Ohio, the Presbytery extends northward to Marion, east to Newark, west to London and southward to the Ohio River. The southern portion of the presbytery is distinguished by an Appalachian culture, where there are many small towns and much rugged open



country. Scioto Valley Presbytery is represented in 21 Counties: Athens, Delaware,

Fairfield, Fayette, Franklin, Gallia, Hocking, Jackson, Knox, Lawrence, Licking, Madison, Marion, Meigs, Morrow, Pickaway, Pike, Ross, Scioto, Union, and Vinton.

Kay has also launched Multipliers' Movement – a gathering of kingdom multipliers for sharing, equipping, and encouraging. She is a CoachU and Advanced CoachU Graduate, an accredited coach (PCC: Professional Certified Coach) with the ICF, International Coaching Federation, a Certified Path 1 Coach, and once served on the faculty at Coaching4Clergy. As a passionate lay person, she has a banking background and has been a business owner for more than 25 years. Kotan has served as a church developer for conferences and worked with churches, pastors, conferences, and judicatory leaders across the country for more than a decade.




